

Rules of Graduation Requirements for English Proficiency for Undergraduate Students of Department of Biological Science and Technology at I-Shou University

Amendments adopted on April 17, 2008 at the second meeting of the Curriculum Committee in the second semester of the academic year 2008

Amendments adopted on April 24, 2008 at the second meeting of the Departmental Affairs Council in the second semester of the academic year 2008

Adopted on June 29, 2009 at the second meeting of the University Academic Council in the second semester of the academic year 2008

- I. Legal Basis: The Rules of Graduation Requirements for English Proficiency for Undergraduate Students of Department of Biological Science and Technology at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the Rules”) are made pursuant to the Regulations for Graduation Requirements for Basic Competences of Students of I-Shou University.
- II. Purpose: The Rules are established with the aim of enhancing students’ English proficiency to help them draw up plans for further education and future employment.
- III. Scope of Application: The Rules shall be applicable to daytime undergraduate students (including transfer students) admitted to the Department in and after the academic year 2009.
- IV. Assessment Criteria:

- V. Implementation: During the prescribed duration of study, students of the Department must not only take all courses required by the Department but also fulfill the criteria on English Proficiency specified above to be eligible for graduation.
- VI. Alternative Measures for Failure to Fulfill the Criteria: Students who fail to meet the requirements for English proficiency may take the courses specially designed junior and senior students for improving English proficiency offered by the Department or the Center for General Education on winter or summer vacations. The tuition is the same as that for summer courses. After the course has been completed, those who pass the course will be considered fulfilling the requirements for English proficiency, and the course on English Proficiency will be registered as “Passed.” Students who have taken any of the English proficiency tests mentioned above three times (once every academic year) will be entitled to a 50% reduction in the tuition, but for once only.
- VII. The Rules become effective after being adopted by the Curriculum Committees at three levels and approved by the University Academic Council. The same procedure applies to any amendment to the Rules.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of these Rules, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
